The Institute

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida Fundació Dr. Pifarré (IRBLleida) was established with the aim of creating synergies between basic, clinical and epidemiological research, making biomedical research a key driver to improve current clinical practice. IRBLleida covers a chain of translational research, from basic research, aimed at understanding the physiological and pathological mechanisms of the human body, to research that studies the behavior of diseases in large population groups.

The Biomedical Research Institute of Lleida (<u>IRBLleida</u>) was founded in 2004 through a cooperation agreement between the University of Lleida (UdL) and the Catalan Healthcare system. IRBLleida integrates research groups of the faculties of Medicine and Nursing and Physiotherapy of the UdL. On the other hand, we incorporate research groups from:

- The Catalan Health Institute (<u>ICS</u>) both at the hospital level (Arnau de Vilanova University Hospital -<u>HUAV</u>) and the primary healthcare of <u>Lleida</u> and the <u>Alt Pirineu-</u> Aran Health Region,
- 2. The healthcare provider <u>Gestió de Serveis Sanitaris</u> (<u>GSS</u>; <u>Santa María University</u> <u>Hospital</u> -<u>HUSM</u>, <u>Pallars Regional Hospital</u> and <u>Mental Health</u>, among others).

IRBLIeida has been a CERCA institute since 2013, and as such is organized according to a model of good governance and operation that ensures efficiency, management flexibility, talent recruitment and promotion, strategic planning and executive capacity. It is also one of the 34 Spanish Health Research Institute (IIS) recognized by the <u>Carlos III Health Institute</u> and the Government of the Generalitat, as established by Law 16/2003, of 28 May, on the cohesion and quality of the national health system.

In December 2014, the Lleida Biomedical Research Institute's received the 'HR Excellence in

These requirements must be met at the beginning of participation in the program.

Context and tasks to be developed:

The selected person will join the Cancer Biomarkers Research Group at IRBLleida. The group is formed by clinical staff belonging to three services of the Hospital Arnau de Vilanova in Lleida (Medical Oncology, Radiation Oncology and Internal Medicine); and by researchers trained in Biosciences. The group's research is translational and is based on 3 main lines of research: 1) breast cancer; ii) digestive tumours and iii) malignant pleural reservoir.

The group needs a full-time candidate with a technical profile to cover the needs of the different lines in a transversal way. The tasks to be performed are as follows:

- Placing and managing orders
- Drawing up and updating laboratory protocols and inventories.
- Supervision of procedures that comply with occupational hazard regulations
- Maintenance of equipment as required
- Processing of biological samples and preparation of patient databases
- Performing and maintaining cell cultures







- Performance of molecular and cellular biology techniques: nucleic acid and protein extraction, agarose electrophoresis and Western blotting, immunohistochemistry and immunofluorescence, vector cloning, etc.

- Support for scientific dissemination activities carried out by the group.
- Training of new researchers in basic laboratory techniques.

Express selection process

When an employee must be replaced urgently, for instance, to cover a sick leave, scientific reasons justifying the incorporation on a specific day, specification in a resolution, etc., an express selection process could be undertaken.
